## **A Career in Massage Therapy Just Became More Accessible**

NEWINGTON, CT—If you’ve ever flirted with the idea of becoming a massage therapist, but never pursued it because you had to work or you thought the time commitment would be more than you could handle, think again. Connecticut Center for Massage Therapy had just such students in mind when it launched its 12-month training schedule this year.

“We’re always soliciting feedback from our students and a common refrain, especially from our younger students, is that they want to do the training in a shorter amount of time and still be able to work part-time,” says CCMT founder Steve Kitts. “The 12-month schedule makes the training more accessible and opens the door to a career in massage therapy for more people.”

The 12-month schedule was designed with the working student in mind. It rearranges all the material in the Full Time Massage Therapy program into a two-days-per week schedule, offered Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. This allows students to still work part-time. The same material is covered in both the 12-month and CCMT’s regular full time program and the cost is the same.

CCMT also offers a 20-month program for those students who desire more training or need to work full time.
