## **Changing Careers? Timing is Everything.**

NEWINGTON, CT (June 24, 2008)—In these days of corporate downsizing, many people are looking to create their own golden parachutes and are going back to school to train for an alternate career in massage therapy before the pink slip arrives. One might expect that such an undertaking would require a schedule as flexible as Houdini, but Connecticut Center for Massage Therapy had the working escape artist in mind when it created its new weekend training schedule.

“Many of the students at CCMT are here because they want to make a career change, but they don’t necessarily have the luxury of quitting the job they have now to go back to school,” says CCMT founder Steve Kitts. “We don’t want scheduling to be an impediment to people who need to work full time, so we’ve created a schedule that can accommodate someone who is thinking about or is in the process of transitioning from one career to another.”

The new weekend schedule for the 20-month Massage Therapy program is offered Tuesdays, from 6 to 10 p.m., and Sundays, from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. This allows students to work full time while training to be a massage therapist and still have one weekend day free. CCMT also offers several other schedules that accommodate a busy lifestyle.
